



Probably the best Gasshuku in the world...

Train with Higaonna Sensei and the European Chief Instructors in the picturesque city of Copenhagen. In a country famous for its beer, smørbrød, Niels Bohr, Hans Christian Andersen and the "happiest people in Europe", there is a wealth of diversity and good experiences to be had!

A unique part of this European Gasshuku is the childrens gasshuku (at 600kr - £60) and "fun events" offer (at 450 kr - £45). Children will be taught by the best in the world every day for 2.5hours and afterwards, whilst the adults train further, parents can sign their children up for a series of organised daily fun events, including climbing and archery.

The gasshuku will be held within the DGI-Byen (City) complex which is located within a 5 - 15 minute walk from all of the main attractions offered by Copenhagen, and literally right across the road from the train station.

Attractions - designer and high street shops, the famous Tivoli gardens and fun fair, museums, theatres, canals, boat trips and restaurants, and, of course, the red light district.

Eating - just like any town, one can eat to suit ones budget, from grabbing a quick sausage from one of the famous sausage wagons to be found all over the city, to michelin star graded restaurants.

Drinking - prices are on a par with all other major European cities, it all depends how much you drink...!

DGI-Byen (City) Hotel is a part of the DGI-Byen complex and includes a swimming pool, gym, bowling, sauna and spa, and restaurant and cafes. If you choose to book at either this hotel or one of the 2 partnership hotels, **Hotel Centrum** and **Hotel Astoria**, you will have free use of all of the amenities within the 'city'. If you choose the **Danhostel** (Denmarks first 5-star designer hostel), you will receive a 10% discount on all the amenities. Breakfast is included at all of these. As an example of how cheap this gasshuku could be; booking the Danhostel before 1st April will cost just £12 per person per night..!
